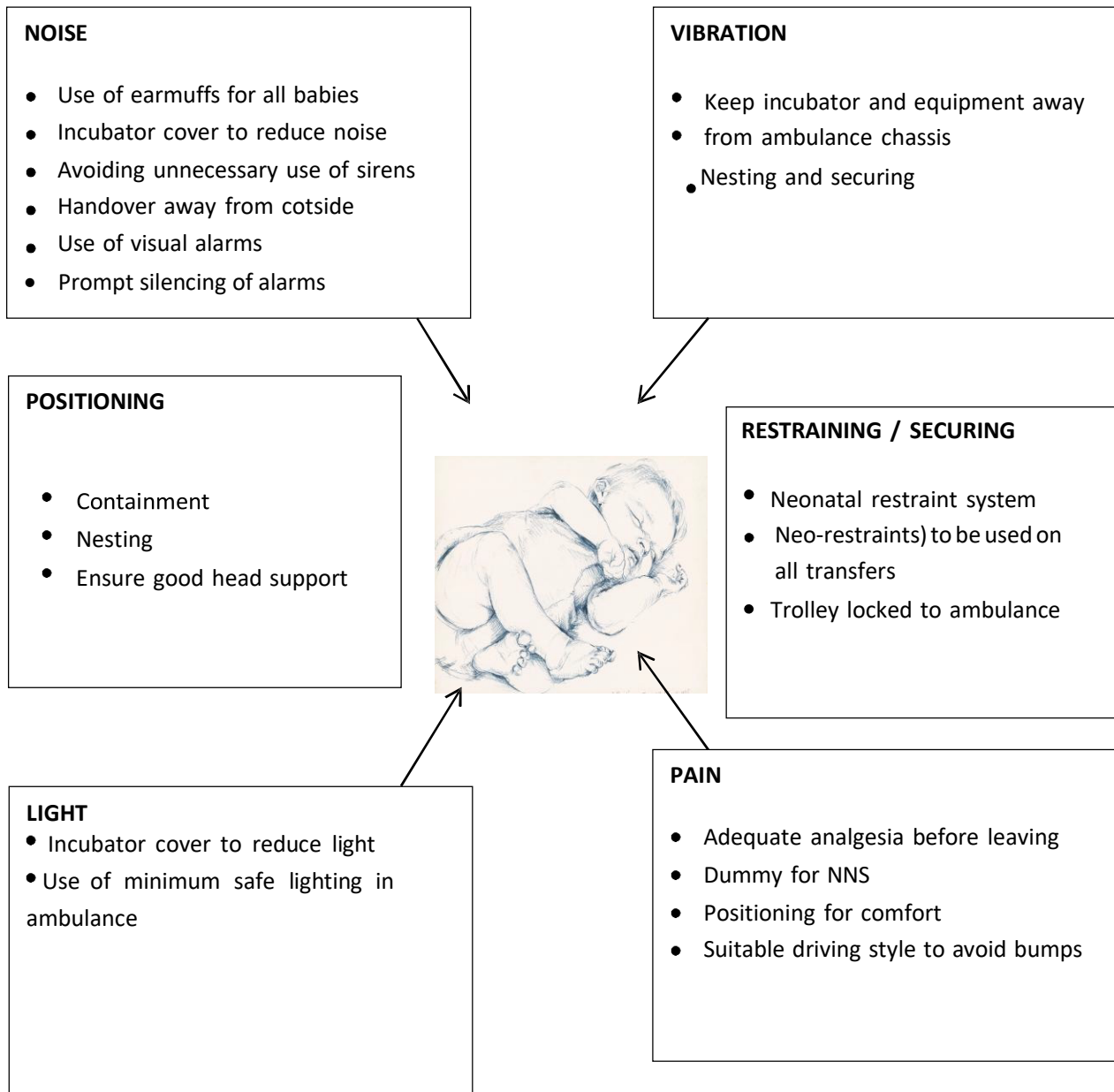


DEVELOPMENTAL CARE DURING TRANSPORT
