


DEVELOPMENTAL CARE DURING TRANPORT

Background

Infants who receive developmentally supportive care during the course of medical treatment in the NICU have improved long-term developmental outcomes. Developmental interventions can be incorporated successfully into the care provided during transport of sick neonates, potentially preventing or reducing neurodevelopmental complications.
