They are a specialist team trained to care for sick newborn and premature babies.

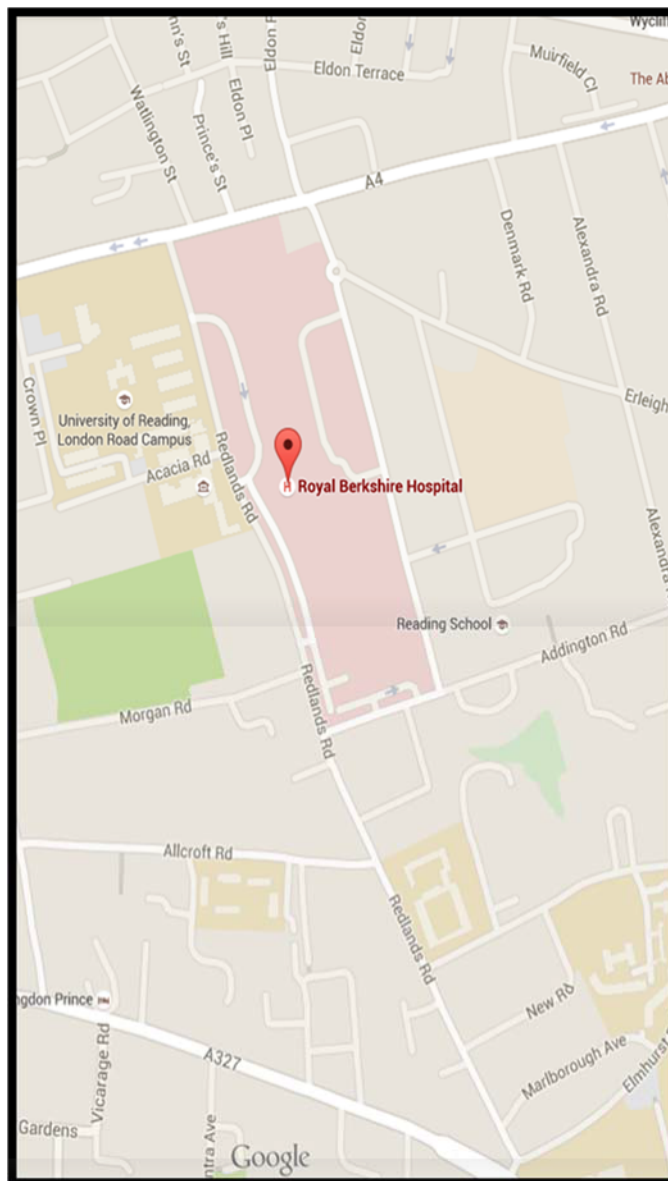
There will be a Doctor/ ANNP, Neonatal Nurse and an Ambulance Driver, all of which are specially trained in neonatal transport.

### **Parking**

Parking for patients and visitors at the Royal Berkshire Hospital is on levels 0, 1, 2 and 3 of the multi-storey car park in Craven Road.

Up to 1 hour £1.50

Up to 2 hours £3.00

Up to 3 hours £4.50

Up to 4 hours £6.00

Up to 6 hours £9.00

All day parking £12

Maximum stay is 24 hours.

Parents with a baby in SCBU are exempt from charges.

There are ATM cash dispenser machines on Level 2 opposite the main reception desk in the main entrance and near Outpatients 1 on Level 2 South Block.
