All are specially trained in neonatal transport.


The ambulance carrying your baby will have all the necessary specialist equipment to continue your baby's care and ensure their safe transfer to a local neonatal unit.

Parking

Subsidised parking is available for parents with a baby on the neonatal unit. The cost of the parking is £2.00 per visit or 24 hour period. This concession only applies to parents with a baby on the neonatal unit, Princess Anne Hospital (PAH). Please take a ticket from the machine when you arrive at the car park. When you are ready to leave, hand your ticket to a member of staff who will validate it for you. The ticket then needs to be paid for at the pay point on level D or B, before leaving the car park.

Local catering outlets/shops

There are alternative food and shopping outlets at the main entrance of SGH (C level, Centre Block) including Costa, Subway, M&S café, WH Smith and M&S simply food and StockShop.
There is a hospital pharmacy for outpatient prescriptions and over the counter medications

Religious support

The chaplain is located on Level D, Centre Block at SGH. The chaplaincy/spiritual care team facilitate and provide spiritual care for patients, carers and staff across the hospital. If the team itself does not contain a chaplain from a requested faith group, they will make every endeavour, through their various community contacts, to locate an appropriate person.
